1. All missions must start and end with prayer. In fact the Bible, our operations manual, tells us we should *never cease* to be in prayer for one another! Pray for the following items:
  - a. *You and your family to grow closer as a team*
  - b. *you and your family to hear and know God's voice above all others*
  - c. *you and your family to have the courage to respond to His voice*
  - d. *the people receiving your mission will see God loves them through a need being met*
  - e. *the people receiving your mission will want to respond and be a part of His Big God Story*
  
2. Complete the directions on the project with your team, always asking the question: **“What needs to be done here?”**. Agent Faithful, you are always on the mission field. God is faithful and He will always show you where the needs are if you are looking and listening. You may be surprised how God can use you in His Big God Story if you're ready and willing!
